Layout Concept: This is a densely packed urban switching layout set in and around Vernon, California (Los Angeles) in 1974. As a result, both the Union Pacific and AT&SF are represented, with the layout’s local trains originating and terminating in separate yards. Local Turns are dispatched sequentially to work a variety of customer spurs using Switch-lists, including a stockyard, fruit packing plant, team tracks, cold storage and an Oscar Meyer plant and others.
