Secrets for Best Direct Route and Best Parking

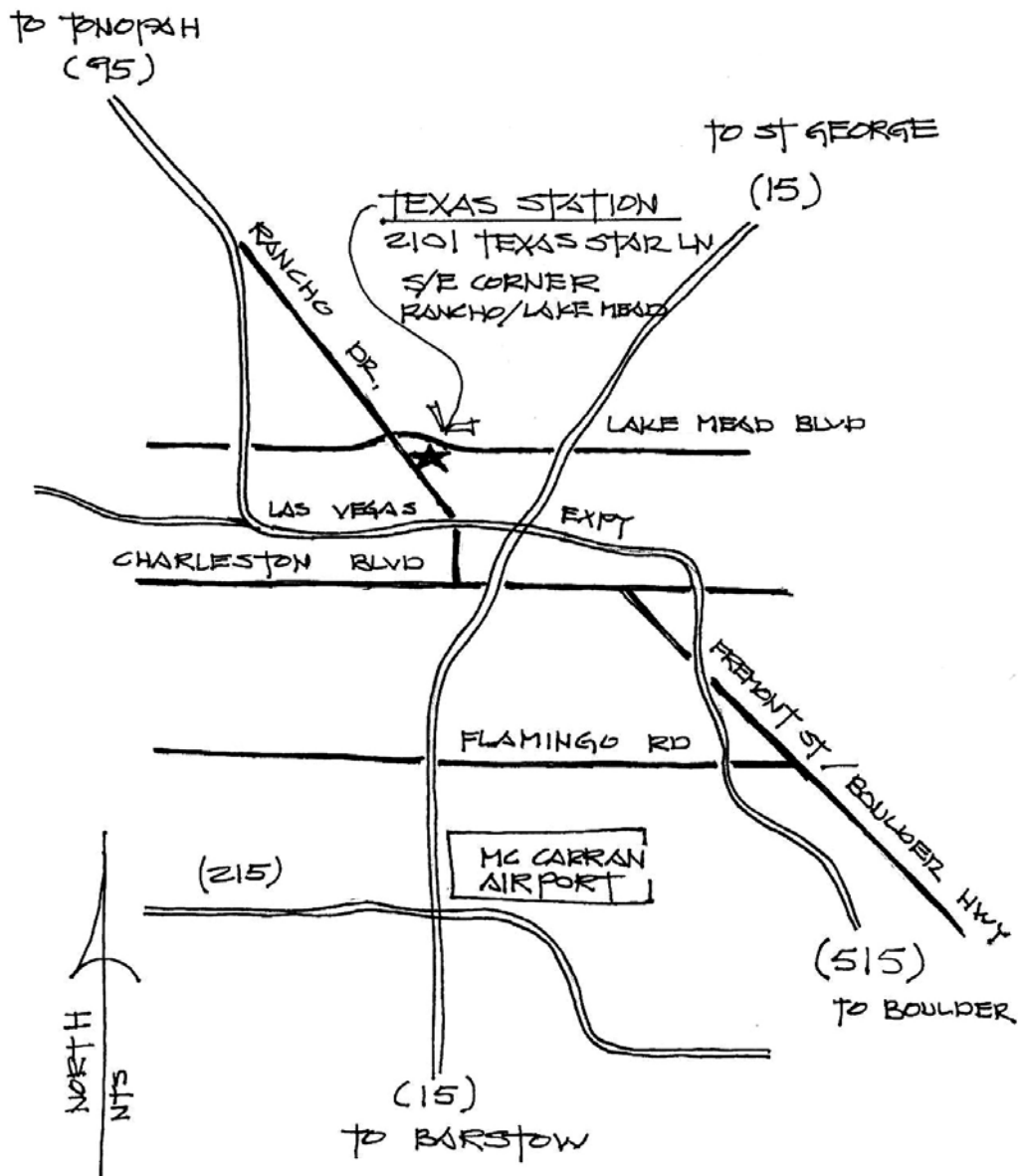
Here are the driving instructions;

Judges Clinic

I am giving a “*So You Want To Be a Judge*” clinic on Friday morning. This clinic is designed for three audiences:

- (1) those people who would like to become a contest judge;
- (2) those people who are already contest judges and would like a refresher, and;
- (3) those very crafty people who don't give a hoot about being a judge, but would like to get higher scores on their contest entries by hearing what judges are looking for.

The clinic is based on the NMRA Judging Guidelines and practical experience from long-time judges. If you attend the clinic you are then “urged” to attend the judging on Friday night .

Three Contests Available

We are doing three contests at the Convention: the Judged Model Contest, the Photo Contest, and the Arts and Crafts Contest. Here is what you'll need for each one:

Judged Model Contest

You need a **Model Contest Entry Form #901** and a **Model Contest Judges Score Sheet Form #902** for each entry.

In addition to the *Regular Awards* the Judged Model Contest also features a *Popular Vote Award*, where the attendees get to vote (no stuffing the ballot box) on their favorite model.

Photo Contest

You need a **Model Contest Entry Form #901** and a **PSR Photo Contest Judges Score Sheet Form #602** for each entry.

We will have four categories:

- *Black and White Print Prototype*
- *Black and White Print Model*
- *Color Print Prototype* and
- *Color Print Model*.

No slides will be accepted (sorry).

Arts and Crafts Contest

You need a **Model Contest Entry Form #901** and a **PSR Arts and Crafts Score Sheet Form #906** for each entry.
