## Western Continental Layout

This freelance layout is inspired by the steam to diesel transition era up to the 1960's, running multiple road names such as Santa Fe, Union Pacific, Southern Pacific, Burlington and Northern Pacific. These railroads covered the western United States from Chicago to Seattle and New Orleans to San Diego.

The layout is still in the construction phase so you will be able to observe our construction techniques. All track is in place with more structures planned and much work to do on scenery on ballasting. Multiple structures were built by the host and are mostly AMB and Bar Mills Kits purchased through estate sales, model railroad swap meets or online.
